Richard West has been Musical Director of the Shepshed Singers since September 2014 and is also Director of Music at the Loughborough Endowed Schools, where he conducts four other choirs. He was a chorister at St Albans Cathedral, before studying music at Durham and Copenhagen Universities. Working in the Music Department at Ampleforth College then led to a PGCE at Cambridge, followed by teaching spells in Bishops Stortford, Haberdashers' Aske's Boys' School in Elstree and at Christ College, Brecon. Along the way, he collected performance diplomas in both piano and singing, and a Masters degree in music composition for media from the University of Hertfordshire.
